The crew is also gearing up for construction on our new connection with Rathbun Regional Water Association for our south supply project. This construction will start in 2020 with the project being complete in 2021.

We would like to thank all of the property owners that granted easement for our south supply project. Having easement for this project will make the job a lot less complicated. We appreciate your generosity.

Water Treatment Plant Update

Our treatment plant has also been gearing up for the changes that will be taking place with our south supply project. With the increased production the treatment plant converted to a bulk coagulant which will result in a significant cost savings.
